

## **Eligibility rule set for driver and / or co-driver**

Our Club recognises there is a balance between promoting and growing motorsport and keeping our members, participants and spectators safe.

**From 1<sup>st</sup> July 2018** Marlborough Car Club has applied minimum licence and age hurdles for competitors. These are purposely kept simple and manageable.

1. Where the venue is one that the Club has secured a Road Closure of a public road, the driver must hold a current NZ civil driving licence
2. Where the holder of a NZ civil licence has not achieved “full licence” endorsement then the applicable supervision rules, as current under the NZ Road Traffic Act, will apply (i.e. supervision by an appropriate person (licence, age etc.)
3. At private venues such as Autocross, a Junior driver (non civil licence holder) may compete from age 12
4. Where a Junior driver is eligible to compete, any passenger must hold a full NZ civil licence and meet the Supervisor rules as applied by the NZ Road Traffic Act, at that time
5. Junior drivers without a NZ civil licence, must obtain permission from a Parent or Guardian to compete. For Basic Events such as Motokhana and Autocross that permission can be given for a period of up to 12 months.
6. Junior drivers with a NZ civil licence, but not a “full licence” endorsement, who compete at events higher than Basic grade, will require parental or guardian permission for each event undertaken.
