SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS 6th September 2026

1: **Jurisdiction:** The event is a ClubSport Advanced Gravel Bent Sprint promoted by the Marlborough Car Club Inc. The event will be held under these Supplementary Regulations the MotorSport NZ National Sporting Code and its Appendices and Schedules, particularly Appendix Five, Schedule C being the standing Regulations for a ClubSport Event, and Appendix Two, Schedule A Driver and Vehicle Safety Requirements, Schedule XC for Cross Cars.

3:1 **The Event and Venue:** The event is to be held on the Tua Marina Track from a point approximately 6 kms from SH 6 junction, 4.5kms from Renwick. (GPS = 41 27'5.81"S 173 52'17.21"E)

The event is on a public gravel based road. The Distance is approximately 3.0kms. There will be a roll call and drivers briefing which **ALL DRIVERS must** attend, followed by a guided tiki tour **and/or** practise run and three timed runs time permitting.

3.2 Classes

Class: A 0 - 1300cc Class: B 1301cc – 1600cc Class: C 1601cc and over 2WD Class: D All 4WD Classic: Pre 1982 XC Cross Cars

4:1 **Entries:** Entries should be made through the MotorSport On Line System. Any entry will not be deemed valid until payment is received.

Alternatively, entries may be submitted manually in "hard copy" form. Such entries must be made on the correct form, must be complete in detail and accompanied by the appropriate fees.

Entries open with the publication of these regulations and close at 10pm Friday 4th September 2026. Entries lodged after this time will not be accepted.

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4.4 Number of Starters

The maximum number of starters will be 40 in total. Any additional entries received will be placed on the Reserve list in order of receipt.

5. Competitor Requirements and Understanding

5.1 Licence Requirements

A driver must hold as a minimum M Grade Competition Licence, Civil Drivers Licence and current membership with a member club.

5.2 Competitor Understanding:

In submitting the entry, competitors (Entrant and Drivers) are deemed to fully understand the MotorSport NZ National Sporting Code and its relevant Appendices and Schedules. In particular: The National Sporting Code Articles pertaining to protests and competitors obligations, and Appendix Five, Schedule C.

5.3 All competitors shall wear safety apparel in compliance with Appendix Two, Schedule A.

6. Eligible Vehicles

6.1 Compliance: All vehicles shall comply with Appendix Five Schedule C and Appendix Two Schedule A and Schedule XC of the current MotorSport Manual unless stated otherwise in these supplementary regulations.

7. Documentation and Scrutineering Audit Inspection

7.1 Documentation: Will take place at the venue commencing at 8.30am and concluding at 9.30 am.

7.2 Scrutineering Audit Inspection: Will take place at the venue commencing at 8.30am and concluding at 9.30am Competitors will be advised at documentation if their vehicle has been selected for audit.

7.3 Drivers' Briefing: This will be held in the Pit area commencing at 9.45am or earlier. Attendance by all drivers is compulsory – a roll call will be taken and failure to attend will result in a penalty.

8. POSTPONEMENT CANCELLATION ABANDONMENT & ORGANISERS' RIGHTS:

9. OFFICIAL BULLETINS

9.1 Official Bulletins may be issued in accordance with the provisions of the National Sporting Code.

10. GENERAL INFORMATION

10.1 Passengers: May only be carried in accordance with Appendix Five, Schedule C Article 6.2.

10.2 Alcohol is not permitted to be consumed by any competitor or their crew at the event before or during the day's competition.

10.3 A maximum of 2 drivers per car

10.4 Tyre choice- Free

10.5 FUEL: Competitors are reminded of their obligations under the Motorsport Code of Practice – Fuel, which is available on the Motorsport New Zealand website.

10.6 Damage: Any damage to public, private or Car Club property must be reported to the officials, and the cost in repairing this damage may be borne by the competitor concerned.

- 10.7 Behaviour:** All entrants are responsible for the behaviour of their respective helpers and or spectators. Please respect the property and take away litter etc.

No Skidding, Hand brake Turns or reckless behaviour in the pit area

- 10.8** For all Advanced Permitted events it is mandatory ruling of the Marlborough Car Club that all competing cars require a Motorsport NZ homologated roll cage and full harness restraints. Vehicles without cages will not be accepted to compete.
- 10.9** Reconnaissance of, or practice on the course prior to the event is strictly prohibited.
